It helps us to be clear about our obligations and responsibilities and demonstrates our commitment to take safeguarding very seriously. Watchwords for us all are:-

DO

- Be aware
- Listen to concerns raised
- Report concerns to the Parish Safeguarding Officer (Louise Whaites 07305 449227) or the Vicar (Steve Kelly – 01604 627680)

DON'T

- Ever be on your own with a child or vulnerable adult
- Ask questions, except to clarify
- Ignore concerns or warning signs
- Promise confidentiality
